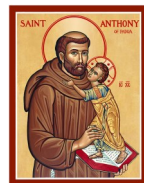

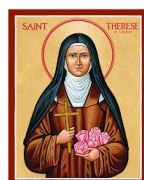

The Pastor's Letter

Twelfth Sunday in Ordinary Time



This bulletin column marks my final one as pastor of Saint Martin of Tours. I looked for the first one I wrote, but I no longer have the file, as it was on an old computer. That is just as well because a lot has changed since August 1, 2019! We went into those months beginning a transition not just from one pastor to another, but of all the priests in residence, and from governance of the parish by priests of the Redemptorist Order back to the Diocese of Rockville Center. Little did anyone know that a few short months later, our parish and our lives would be thrown into chaos by the COVID-19 pandemic. When I was asked after the pandemic whether the parish was back to normal yet, my response was that I had never experienced what normal was.

Among the highlights of my seven years here was the celebration of the 100th Anniversary of both the parish and the church building. We had a thirteen-month-long celebration bookended by the centennials of the first Mass in the parish and the church's dedication. We were able to celebrate the parish's history, reunite with those who had moved away, honor the legacy of Catholic education here, and renew connections between parish members and the Bethpage community as a whole.

Thank you to the staff and volunteers, and to everyone who has provided assistance to the parish and its priests during these years. I encourage anyone who has considered becoming more involved in the parish to please do so! Many hands make light work, and much of the parish's behind-the-scenes work is carried out by a very small but very dedicated group of people.

On Wednesday at 12 noon, Fr. Michael and Fr. Iroh will arrive and begin their ministry here at St. Martin's. Please welcome them (and give them a little time before making many requests). They are members of the Congregation of the Mission, also known as the Vincentians. Although they are members of a religious congregation, such as the Redemptorists, they are in a different community with a different founder, history, and charism. They will bring with them the influence and intercession of Saint Vincent de Paul.

During the 100th anniversary year, I used the example of the great European cathedrals that often took more than a century to complete. Those who designed them and laid the first stones never saw the finished product. The completed churches were the result of generations of work and support! A generation started, and then every following generation received from the one before it, and hopefully added to it, and so handed it on to the next. It's the same for a parish. We received from those before us, hopefully we are good stewards, and then we hand it over to those who follow after us.

I will conclude with these words from Saint Paul's First Letter to the Corinthians, "What is Apollos, after all, and what is Paul? Ministers through whom you became believers, just as the Lord assigned each one. I planted, Apollos watered, but God caused the growth. Therefore, neither the one who plants nor the one who waters is anything, but only God, who causes the growth."

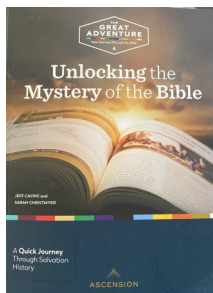


